These options allow your users to release print jobs from their personal Secure Print queues safely. Your users can also be granted different access rights to various functions, depending on their job role.




4. CREATE INTELLIGENT DOCUMENT PROCESSES





9. PROCESS ALL CAPTURED INFORMATION


